- A. PART I GENERAL
- A1. Scope of Work
- A. Base Project: The Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, tools and equipment required to Construct Security Lockout for Exterior Doors. The project involves campus-wide installation of a security lockout system, including card access, door position switches, door hardware, and associated cabling/infrastructure. The project shall be accomplished per the contract drawings and specifications.

This work includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. Demolition of existing card access cabling and system components where replaced by the new system.
- 2. Contractor shall remove from the VA site and dispose of all equipment and materials not scheduled to be reused.
