
Installation of New Access Points

Once the Cabling is in place and Access Points have been received. The local IT staff should follow the AP Installation and Removal guide in order to place the access points in the proper locations in the above layout and Design view. (5 Step Process)

» Pull the ceiling grid bracket apart, place it on the ceiling grid, and slide the ceiling grid bracket together. Tighten the 2 screws to hold the bracket on the ceiling grid (one on each side).




» Place the surface mount bracket to the ceiling grid bracket; align the screw holes so that all 4 screws will be screwed in place. Hand-tighten the 4 screws.




» Apply FIPS Kit applicable to the AP to be installed.






» Slide the New Access Point by matching the tabs on the mounting bracket to the posts on the AP



» Apply a secured cable (zip-tie) through the opening.



» Access point should look like this from the ceiling once completed.
