Under the terms and conditions set forth in the Network Contracting Office 23 ND/SD Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Multiple Award Task Order Contract (MATOC), VA Network Contracting Office 23 (NCO 23) requests that you provide a price proposal for the above referenced project as described below and in the attached Construction Documents. The following information is provided to assist you in preparing your proposal:

Note: All documentation submittal due times are local time (Central Time).

Note: If a firm is **not submitting** a proposal, you are requested to **submit a "No Bid" response** via email to the Contracting Officer or through Vendor Portal within five (5) business days from receipt of the RFP.

 SCOPE: Construction work shall include, but shall not be limited to providing all labor, materials, deliveries, equipment, etc. necessary to complete Fargo VA Health Care System construction project 437-23-125: Replace Selected Roofing. All work shall be in accordance with Contracting Documents, Scope of Work (SOW), NFPA, local building codes, VA facility standards, and other applicable requirements.

2. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:

- 2.1. The contractor shall commence work under this contract within 14 calendar days after the date the Contractor receives the Notice to Proceed (NTP), prosecute the work diligently, and complete the entire work ready for use not later than 215 calendar days from the contractor's receipt of the NTP. The time stated for completion shall include final cleanup of the premises.
- 2.2. Working hours will be 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM (CT) unless otherwise stated in the SOW/drawings/specifications or pre-arranged with the local VA Engineering Office/Contracting Officer's Representative (COR).
- 3. NAICS CODE: 238160, Roofing Contractors, size standard \$19.0M.

- 4. OFFER ACCEPTANCE PERIOD: Offers providing less than 45 calendar days for Government acceptance after the date offers are due may not be considered and may be rejected.
- **5. MAGNITUDE OF CONSTRUCTION:** Between \$1,000,000.00 and \$2,000,000.00

6. BONDS:

- 6.1. Bid Guarantee: Yes. 20% as indicated in FAR Provision 52.228-1.
 - 6.1.1. Note: A scanned copy of the stamped Bid Guarantee shall be provided with the proposal.
- 6.2. Performance and Payment Bonds: **Yes.** Performance and payment bonds in the amount of 100% of the awarded CLIN(s) shall be required. Bonds shall be submitted for approval to the Contracting Officer within 10 days after award of the task order. Commencement of construction is contingent upon approval of required bonds.

- 8. SITE VISIT: An organized Site Visit has been scheduled for Wednesday January 18 at 3:00pm CT. Participants will meet at the Fargo VA Medical Center, building 1, room BD-42. Offerors are strongly encouraged to visit the VA installation to fully appraise themselves with the physical layout and the character and conditions under which the service is to be performed. Failure to do so will in no way relieve the successful offeror from the necessity of furnishing the services as specified in this proposal without additional cost to the Government.
 - **8.1.** Due to the current pandemic, a face mask will be required at all times while at the VA facility and only one representative from each company (general contractor & subcontractors) may attend the site visit. All Visitors will be pre-screened for symptoms of COVID-19. Please allow enough time to ensure you arrive by the site visit start time.
- 9. **SOLICITATION QUESTIONS/CLARIFICATIONS:** Questions must be submitted to the vendor portal. Questions will be accepted up to **Tuesday January 31, 2023 at 3:00pm CT.** All answers will be published to vendor portal via an amendment. The Government reserves the right to not answer any RFIs/questions after the stated due date/time.

10. PROPOSAL FORMAT:

- **10.1.** Proposals submitted in response to this solicitation shall be submitted via the eCMS Vendor Portal and formatted as follows:
 - 10.1.1. Offerors shall submit a cover letter and price proposal in the form of electronic documents. The cover letter shall include:
 - 10.1.1.1. The solicitation number.

- 10.1.1.2. The name, address, telephone and facsimile numbers, and e-mail addresses of the offeror.
- 10.1.1.3. A statement specifying the extent of agreement with all terms, conditions, and provisions included in the solicitation and agreement to furnish all items upon which prices are offered at the price set opposite each item.
- 10.1.1.4. Names, titles, phone numbers, facsimile numbers, and e-mail addresses of persons authorized to negotiate on the offeror's behalf with the Government in connection with this solicitation, and:
- 10.1.1.5. Name, title, and signature of person authorized to sign the proposal.
- 10.1.1.6. The price proposal shall be in the format provided in Price Schedule Sheet and Attachment A, Price Schedule Breakdown Sheet. The price proposal shall provide the total price and a price breakdown for the specified Divisions specified specifically for this project in Attachment A.
- 10.1.1.7. Electronic documents shall be submitted in Microsoft Word and/or Microsoft Office Excel as applicable. An additional copy of all documentation shall be submitted using portable document format (.pdf).
- 10.1.1.8. Minimum Submission Requirements: In order to be considered for award, the offeror is required to submit, at a minimum, the following:
 - 10.1.1.8.1. Signed SF-1442
 - 10.1.1.8.2. Signed Amendment(s) SF-30, if any.
 - 10.1.1.8.3. Solicitation provided Price Schedule and Attachment A-Price Schedule Breakout that contains pricing for the entire requirement.
 - 10.1.1.8.4. Safety or Environmental Information in accordance with the written instructions stated herein.

11. BASIS OF AWARD: Price Only

11.1. **EVALUATION PROCEDURES:**

- 11.1.1. The offeror's proposed price will be initially evaluated by the Contracting Officer (CO) for completeness. The Government will evaluate pricing for award purposes by reviewing the cost breakdown provided using the attached Price Schedule Breakdown Sheet. The Government may determine that an offer is unacceptable if the proposal prices are significantly unbalanced. A proposal price is unbalanced when the proposal is based on prices significantly less than the cost for some work and/or significantly overstated for other work. Price Completeness: Price proposals will be evaluated to determine if the proposal contains costs to perform all tasks as required by the Statement of Work, Specifications and Design Drawings.
- 11.1.2. Price Reasonableness: Reasonableness is based on the total evaluated price compared to historical prices for similar efforts, comparison to the Independent Government Estimate (IGE), and price competition obtained by the offeror's proposals submitted in response to this RFP. A reasonable price represents an amount that a prudent person would pay

in a competitive business environment.

11.1.3. Price reasonableness will be established using any necessary price/cost analysis techniques in FAR 15.404-1, including but not limited to price competition information and the Independent Government Cost Estimate (IGCE), along with any other pricing tools deemed necessary.

The offeror shall:

Submit the properly filled out Price Schedule, included in the solicitation.

Provide a cost breakdown based on the attached Price Schedule Breakdown Sheet, for the base bid and all alternative bids (if applicable).

An award cannot be made if the successful offer's proposal price exceeds available funding or cost limitations (if applicable).

- 11.2. **Selection and Award without Discussions:** It is the intent of the Government to make award based upon initial offers, without further discussions or additional information but the Government reserves the right to conduct such if so needed.
- **12. SITE SUPERVISION:** The Contractor shall provide supervision in accordance with contract clause 52.236-6, Superintendence by the Contractor.

13. CLAUSES:

- 13.1. All applicable Clauses of the base IDIQ contract for each offeror are incorporated into this solicitation in full force and effect.
- 13.2. FAR 52.222-23, NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION TO ENSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY FOR CONSTRUCTION (FEB 1999). Goals for minority participation for each trade and Goals for female participation for each trade: Minority: 0.7%; Female: 6.9%.
- 14. SYSTEM FOR AWARD MANAGEMENT (SAM): Contractors must ensure that their registration in SAM is up-to-date at time of proposal due date and prior to award of a task order. For more information, see the SAM website at System for Award Management (sam.gov). A task order cannot be awarded to a contractor that is not registered and current in SAM.

15. SAFETY OR ENVIRONMENTAL VIOLATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

MODIFICATION RATE

15.1. All Offerors shall submit information pertaining to their past Safety and Environmental record. The information must contain a certification that the bidder/offeror has no more

than three (3) serious, or one (1) repeat or one (1) willful OSHA or any EPA violation(s) in the past three years. If such certification cannot be made, a Bidder/Offeror shall explain why and submit as much information as possible regarding the circumstances of its past safety and environmental record, including the number of EPA violations and/or the number of serious, repeat, and/or willful OSHA violations, along with a detailed description of those violations.

- 15.2. All Bidders/Offerors shall submit information regarding their current Experience Modification Rate (EMR). This information shall be obtained from the Bidder's/Offeror's insurance carrier and be furnished on the insurance carrier's letterhead. If a Bidder/Offeror's EMR is above 1.0, Bidder/Offeror must submit a written explanation of the EMR from its insurance carrier furnished on the insurance carrier's letterhead, describing the reasons for the EMR, and the anticipated date the EMR may be reduced to 1.0 or below.
- 15.3. Self-insured contractors or other contractors that cannot provide their EMR rating on insurance letterhead must obtain a rating from the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI) by completing/submitting form ERM-6 and providing the rating on letterhead from NCCI. Note: Self-insured contractors or other contractors that cannot provide EMR rating on insurance letterhead from the states or territories of CA, DE, MI, NJ, ND, OH, PA, WA, WY, and PR shall obtain their EMR rating from their state-run worker's compensation insurance rating bureau.
- 15.4. If the NCCI cannot issue an EMR because the Bidder/Offeror lacks insurance history, Bidder/Offeror shall submit a letter indicating so from its insurance carrier furnished on the insurance carrier's letterhead and include a letter from the NCCI indicating that is has assigned Bidder/Offeror a Unity Rating of 1.0.
- 15.5. The above information, along with other information obtained from Government systems, such as the OSHA and EPA online inspection history databases, will be used to make an initial Determination of Responsibility.
- 15.6. This requirement is applicable to all subcontracting tiers, and prospective prime contractors are responsible for determining the responsibility of their prospective subcontractors.
